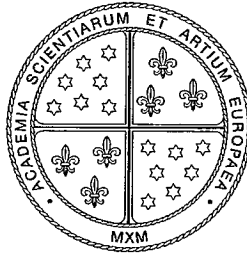

Dear colleague Woznicki,

It is with great pleasure that I inform you today that you have been elected by our nomination committee at the last senate meeting on March 6th, 2015 to become an

of the European Academy of Sciences and Arts.

The European Academy of Sciences and Arts is a European academic forum with 1,700 members. The Academy is a transnational, interdisciplinary body, which works especially on European issues and tries to build solid bridges in a bridges building Europe.

The 1,700 members are allocated in 7 classes, which are Humanities, Medicine, Arts, Natural Sciences, Social Sciences/Law/Economics, Technical/Environmental Sciences and World Religions.

In all classes, we carry yearly several projects out and we hold intensive and detailed workshops and symposiums. Moreover, we have 10 institutes, which work intensively on specific issues.

Among the 1,700 members, we have 5 Nobel Prize winners as well as Pope Benedict XVI, who joined us as Cardinal in 1992. In addition, we welcomed 32 Nobel Prize winners as honorary members in our Academy.

The main topics of the Academy are the projects "Health in the Regions" which has been mandated to us by the European Commissioners Hahn and Dalli as well as the "Danube Academies Conference" (DAC), which works as counterbalance and supplement to the "Danube Rectors' Conference". Further main achievements of the Academy are "Interreligious Dialogues" and the development of a "Tolerance Charta", a "Manifest of Freedom of Sciences" and a "Manifest for Europe".

As our knowledge should also be passed on, we established our own University, the Alma Mater Europaea, which, in the meaning of our Academy, provides the knowledge of our Academics to our youth. I could imagine that you are also interested to participate in this endeavour.

We are very glad, dear colleague Woznicki, to convey this message to you today. Nevertheless, we also have to remark at this point that the yearly membership fee accounts for € 100,-. As we do not receive any official funding apart from the Republic of Austria, we depend on these membership fees.


We also ask our members for an entrance fee of € 150,-, which is payable once.
